Jack reported that he had attended the last meeting arranged by the NHS Oxfordshire Clinical Commissioning Group of the Forum shared by local PPGs which meets from time to time, and which members and practice managers are invited to attend. About twelve people attended this meeting, which was addressed on, and discussed, three major topics: **addressing and meeting the needs of seldom heard groups** (e.g., black and minority ethnic communities, refugees and asylum seekers and vulnerable migrants, the older and disabled, etc); **Oxfordshire's Transformation Programme** (early thinking on cooperating in developing future models of care in different service areas: maternity, children, mental health, etc.); and **Sharing Patients' Records** (online ways and uses of accessing patient records by various parties and individual patients.)
